**Tuition Credit Available!** \$1,000 New Student Credit – any new K-8 student who enrolls in the 2017-2018 school year will receive a \$1,000 credit. Additionally, need -based tuition assistance is available for all families and these credits do not affect the amount of tuition assistance a family may receive.

**25% Referral Credit** – Current or new families who refer another family will receive a 25% tuition credit for the 2017-2018 school year if the family enrolls. Refer more than 1 family – receive an additional 10% for the 2017-2018 school year for each additional family. This credit does not affect the amount of need-based tuition assistance a family may receive. Referrals are credited per new family regardless of number students in a family.

## **ROAD TO RECOVERY WITH THE AMERICAN CANCER SOCIETY**

What do we do:

When transportation is a cancer patient's biggest roadblock to treatment, we help provide the rides that can help save lives. The American Cancer Society Road To Recovery program offers cancer patients free transportation to and from their cancer-related treatment. For those who cannot drive themselves or have no other means of getting to treatment, volunteers donate their spare time and the use of their personal vehicle to give cancer patients in their community a much-needed ride.

### **How Does It Work?**

To ensure quality drivers, the American Cancer Society screens every volunteer. They must also complete a training course to prepare them for their new role. Requirements? A good driving record, a current, valid driver's license, access to a safe and reliable vehicle, proof of adequate automobile insurance, complete an American Cancer Society training course, availability Monday through Saturday between 7 am and 7 pm.
